

Thornton Abbey to Ulceby



From platform 2 at Thornton Abbey railway station take the white exit gate and follow the public footpath sign along the side of Station Farm Barn with the railway on your left.



Follow the footpath for 20 minutes with large open fields to your right. Take care of the ditch to your left.



At the end of the footpath you emerge onto Carr Lane with Bystaple Lane level crossing to your left. Do not cross the level crossing. Instead, follow Carr Lane southwards towards Ulceby.



You are on this peaceful country lane for about 30 minutes, passing farms and open fields until you reach Ulceby. This is a very quiet country road, but there could be vehicles, so take extra care.

At the end of Carr Lane you come to Ulceby Skitter. Turn left onto Station Road and shortly you arrive at Ulceby Railway Station.



This route is on country foot paths and roads so makes a great walk route. Whilst it can be cycled, you may come across some uneven terrain, and for this reason it may be difficult for wheelchairs too. Care should be taken, because whilst the roads are very quiet, there could be vehicles. It's a moderately easy route and takes about 1 hour and 10 minutes on foot.
